Dear Parents or Guardians:

Thank you for inquiring about enrollment in the Chenango Valley Nursery School (CVNS) for the 2019-2020 school years. To secure your spot please return your registration papers and your non-refundable registration fee of \$50 for the first child and \$15 for each additional child. CVNS offers a variety of programs for children ages 2 to 5 years. Brief descriptions of each program and relevant registration information can be found in the sections below. We will start registration for the 2019-2020 school years on Monday March 4th 2019.

Philosophy

The philosophy of the Chenango Valley Nursery School program is to help each child develop to their full potential socially, emotionally, physically, and intellectually. Pre-school children learn through active, hands-on purposeful play. Guided by knowledgeable teachers, the child will learn by "doing." They are active learners who gain knowledge by acting directly on and with concrete objects. Through these actions they can draw conclusions about their world.

Chenango Valley Nursery School believes:

A positive self-concept develops in children who can fulfill their goals, accomplish tasks on their own, and cooperate with others and receive positive feelings from others. Self-disciplined children can direct their efforts towards fulfillment of their goals. Children learn self-discipline through understanding, commitment, and reinforcement. Self-reliance is achieved by allowing children to do as many things for themselves as they are capable of, but keeping in mind new skills.

We know that choosing the right program for your child can be challenging. Please do not hesitate to ask your teacher if you need help making the most appropriate placement for your child.

Every attempt will be made to honor each parent's request for placement in a specific class.

SPROUTS Program (Two Year Olds): Must be 2 years old by August 1st 2019

- Children attend school without an adult.
- Twice-a-week class sessions are: Monday/ Wednesday - 9:15-11:15 am Tuesday/Thursday - 9:15-11:15am or 12:45-2:45 pm
- If we have enough interest we may open an additional class Monday/Wednesday PM
- The yearly tuition is \$1,350 and can be broken into 10 monthly payments of \$135.
- Sprouts program is limited to 8 9 students per class. A minimum of 5 students is required to offer each class.

Our Sprout Program is focused on providing a caring, secure and social environment where children can feel comfortable enough to start exploring the world around them. Activities to promote these skills are combined around fun themes, based on cognitive, language, motor and self-help skills that are developmentally appropriate for two-year old children.

PRESCHOOLERS Program (Three Year Olds): Must be 3 years old by Dec 1st 2019

- Twice-a-week class sessions are :
 - o Tuesday/Thursday 9:00-11:30 am or 12:30 -3:00 pm
- The yearly tuition for 2 days is \$1,400 and can be broken into 10 monthly payments of \$140.
- Three-day-a-week class sessions are:
 - o Monday/Wednesday/Friday program 9:00-11:30 am or 12:30-3:00 pm
- The yearly tuition for 3 days is \$1,600 and can be broken into 10 monthly payments of \$160.
- A minimum of 8 students is required to offer each class.
- Children should be toilet trained.

Our Preschooler Program is based on the knowledge that Three year olds learn primarily through exploring, and using all the senses. While playing, they are better able to focus at the task at hand and persist at problem solving. Every day we will be involved in a variety of activities. The instruction is hands-on, allowing each child to experiment and explore. The day is divided into Large Group Time, Small Group Time, Free Choice Time, Snack and Large Muscle Time.

PRE-K Program (4 & 5 year olds) must be 4 years old by Dec 1st 2019

- Class meets five-days a week: Monday-Friday
- Morning session 9:00-11:30 am
- Afternoon session 12:30-3:00 pm
- The yearly tuition is \$2,500 and can be broken into 10 monthly payments of \$250.
- A minimum of 6 students per class is required to offer these programs.
- Children should be toilet trained.

The PRE-K Program is focused on providing children an opportunity to develop their social, emotional, cognitive and physical skills. These skills will enhance self-esteem and set the foundation for successful learning in any environment and will ease the transition into Kindergarten routines. Every day we will be involved in a variety of activities. Some activities are teacher-directed and others are child-directed. The instruction is hands-on, allowing each child to experiment and explore. The day is divided into Large Group Time, Small Group Time, Free Choice Time, Snack and Large Muscle Time.
